Tips for a Waste Wise Event:

- Use washable plates, mugs, glasses and utensils
- Secure an event location with a kitchen to wash dishes, or bring along totes to take dirty dishes away
- Use cloth napkins and table cloths.
- Alternatively, if you have to use disposables, use paper plates, napkins (dye-free), and wooden utensils that can be composted
- Ensure there are separate collection bins for recyclables so they can be properly rinsed and recycled
- Supply pitchers of tap water. Or set up a water refill station using a 5 gallon bottle of water
- Include foods that are locally grown (much lower shipping costs). Check out Cariboo Growers Co-op store for great options
- Get the guests sorting: provide clearly-marked and labeled recycling and compost bins next to the garbage bin
- Decorate with natural materials that can be reused and/or composted, (natural wreaths, apple tea light holders, etc.)
